Bryant Parks and Recreation Director's Report May 2024

The following took place during the month of April:

- Parks Master Plan was completed, endorsed by the Parks Committee and adopted by City Council.
- Bishop Park hosted Salem Elementary Fishing Derby on April 6.
- Prepared, monitored and managed cleanup for all parks during the Solar Eclipse on April 8.
- Bishop Park hosted a 2D Sports baseball tournament on April 13-14.
- Bishop Park hosted a USA softball tournament on April 27. Many neighboring sites were unable to play that day due to heavy rainfall the night before; we not only played but started on time.
- Mills Pool Replaster project completed and Mills Pool will be opening on schedule Memorial Day weekend.
- We have sold 150 preseason passes to Mills Pool, nearly doubling last year's number at this time.
- New lane ropes installed at Bishop Park lap pool.
- Certified 4 new Lifeguard Instructors, 2 of which work in our facility.
- We only have 4 spots remaining available at the Bishop Park Community garden and most plots are already growing.
- We had 37 pavilion rentals at Mills Park, Ashley Park and Bishop Park pavilions, generating over \$1100 in revenue.
- Installed posts on Mills trail for a storywalk in partnership with Saline County Library.
- Made improvements to the rain garden at Mills playground.

Equipment Description	Reason for sending to Auction
06 Chevy Silverado	Possibly Blown Head Gasket. Replaced with truck from Public Works last year.
60" Zero Turn Mower	Needs major mechanical fix, costly. Replaced with 72" Diesel Kubota a couple years ago.
Toro Groundmaster Mower	No longer able to keep up with workload. Replaced with 100" Toro to cut fields.
John Deer Gator	Currently not running. Didn't run well when it did. Replaced with Kubota Side x Side a couple years ago.
6 Wheel Diesel Cart	PD gave it to us over 10 years ago. Doesn't run.
Ford Tractor	Replaced with New Holland in 2018.
Genie Lift	Too large for Parks needs. Former police chief brought it back from an auction years ago and has never been used.
Bobcat Skidsteer	Older foot operated skidsteer. Has had constant mechanical issues deeming it practically unusable.
Welder/Generator	Quit generating power. Replaced with smaller, portable wire welder and portable generator.
3-point Aerifier	Old and worn out. Replaed by aeravator attachment on Ventrac.
6' x 14' utility trailer	Has some mechanical damage and there are no places to tie down equipment. Replaced in 2022 with longer utility trailer.
Wood Chipper	Doesn't get used.
Tiller	Gear box is no longer functional and it is worn out.
