It also raises the minimum take or pay threshold from .75 MGD to 1.2 MGD. Bryant rarely takes less than 1.2 MGD. AHTD Highway 5 Widening Project - The City has a contract with Crist Engineers for engineering services related to the relocation of City utilities along the Highway 5 corridor to be widened. We are waiting on approval of the contract by AHTD before Crist can begin work.

	A. 16" Force Main - The bore is completed under Interstate 30. Work is ahead of schedule.		
	 B. Boone Road Water Line Replacement - Engineering is complete on the project to replace all of the asbestos cement water line on Boone Road. The project will be ready to bid in the near future. Construction will likely start late in 2015 and overlap into 2016. It is anticipated that the project will cost approximately \$500,000. Alan Schrader, developer of Hayden Creek Subdivision, has agreed to do a portion of the line between NW 4th and Boone Road. The 2015 budget has \$300,000 for water line replacement. Another \$300,000 is proposed for the 2016 budget. C. Sludge Removal Bids - Preconstruction conference is scheduled for October 29, 2015. The Notice to Proceed will be set for November 2.
