Subject: Water & Wastewater Rate Analysis and Recommendations

Dear Mr. Grimmett:

Per your request, I have reviewed my rate recommendations I presented at last December's Water and Wastewater Advisory Committee and the Bryant City Council

The original analysis recommended a one-step increase to water and sewer rates. The following describes recommended rate increases if implemented over a three year period:

- Water Rates: Increase the minimum charge and charges for usage over the minimum by 2% per year for three years.
- Wastewater Rates: Increase the minimum charge and charges for usage over the minimum by 1.5% per year for three years. were reviewed to consider increasing rates over a three year period.

Water rate recommendations are anticipated to cover the increased cost of purchased water over the three year period.

Both recommendations will generate sufficient revenues to meet the target ratios described in the Water & Wastewater Rate Analysis.

Attached are detailed descriptions of the recommendations phased in over three year.

Also attached are water and wastewater rate comparisons with similar systems within Saline and surrounding counties. Highlighted are the statewide percentiles for the minimum charge (2,000 gallons) and the charge for average residential usage (4,000 gallons.

City of Bryant water rates are comparatively low: ranked in the low 9th percentile for 2,000 gallons, and 24th for 4,000 gallons. City of Bryant wastewater rates are higher, ranked 59th for 2,000 gallons, and 85th for 4,000 gallons.

The survey data was taken from the Arkansas Retail Sewer Rate Survey completed by the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission, October 2016.

Water and wastewater rates, however, reflect the unique debt service, operating, and maintenance costs associated with a specific utility. Public financing agencies typically use an "affordability index" to determine debt capacity of a public water or wastewater system. The affordability index represents the percent of Median Household Income needed by an average 4,000 gallons per month residential customer to pay their water or sewer charge. Residential rates within 1.5% to 2.0% of MHI are considered affordable.

Both current and recommended water and wastewater rates are well within the affordability index.

A modest adjustment in user rates of approximately 6% for water and 4.5% for wastewater should be sufficient for at least the next three years. Beyond that time, decisions related to the funding of capital improvements may have an impact on future rates.
