ORDINANCE 2012-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BRYANT BILLBOARD ORDINANCE 2006-42 TO CLARIFY REQUIREMENTS FOR BILLBOARD RELOCATION AND ALTERATION PERMITS; AND TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF BILLBOARDS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bryant Arkansas adopted the Bryant Billboard Ordinance 2006-42 on October 23, 2006; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2011 the Planning Commission of the City of Bryant, Arkansas conducted a duly advertised public meeting concerning proposed amendments to the Bryant Billboard Ordinance, subsequent to which they certified the proposed amendments to the City Council for its adoption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bryant, Arkansas finds that the following amendments to the Bryant Billboard Ordinance 2006-42 are in the best interest of development of the City of Bryant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYANT:

1. That Ordinance 2006-42 of the City of Bryant shall be amended as follows:

SECTION II - REGULATED OFF-PREMISE SIGN REQUIREMENTS:

- B. Billboard requirements:
 - 1. There will be no new billboards allowed within the city limits of Bryant, Arkansas.
 - 4. Billboards shall not be altered with regard to size, shape, orientation, height, or location without the prior issuance of a billboard alteration or relocation permit. All such permits shall require full compliance with the provisions of this ordinance. Ordinary and necessary repairs which do not change the size, shape orientation, height, or location of an inventoried billboard shall not require alteration permits but may require a relocation permit.
 - 6. Billboards on Arkansas Highways 5 and 183 will not be allowed to relocate within the city limits of Bryant. However, they may relocate to Interstate 30 provided the owner obtains a relocation permit. Billboards will meet the City of Bryant, Arkansas Highway Department, and Federal Highway regulations. An application/registration request must be submitted to the Bryant Planning Commission for review and approval.
 - 8. All non-grandfathered billboards will have a maximum size of 14 feet by 48 feet and will be spaced no closer than 1000 feet from another billboard. Requests to relocate existing billboards shall comply with the requirements of this paragraph.

2. That any ordinance or regulation that conflicts with this ordinance is hereby repeale the extent of such conflict.	d to
