RESOLUTION APPROVING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PROPERTY CLEAN UP UNDER ORDINANCE NO.: 2012-30

WHEREAS, the City of Bryant enacted Ordinance No. 2012-30 for the purpose of establishing procedures and processes to clean up unsightly and unsanitary conditions of real property;

WHEREAS, the City of Bryant has certain properties located within its corporate limits that are in need of clearance of unsightly and unsanitary conditions;

WHEREAS, the City of Bryant Code enforcement has taken all steps required under Ordinances and State Law to provide notice to interested parties to certain real property that is unsightly and unsanitary, and has provided sufficient notice of Hearing before the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryant has taken steps to remedy the below listed properties of their unsightly and unsanitary conditions, and in so doing has incurred certain expenses that are hereby affirmed as true and correct expenses incurred by the City of Bryant associated with each below listed property.

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing was provided to interested parties in the below listed properties, such hearing being held on August 25, 2015 at the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting, and the City Council finds that the procedural requirements have been met, the property owners given the appropriate opportunity to remedy the locations, and therefore finds that the costs identified herein were incurred by the City to remediate the unsightly and unsanitary conditions and therefore Directs that the appropriate steps be taken to list these amounts owed to the City of Bryant as a lien on the below listed properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Bryant confirms the City incurred the following expenses for each described property or address provided herein below:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2015-20, CLARIFYING COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT AND AMORTIZATION SCHEDULE TO TRANSFER ADMINISTRATION OF RETIREMENT COVERAGE FOR ELIGIBLE MEMBERS OF THE BRYANT FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUND TO THE ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM (LOPFI) AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN IRREVOCABLE AGREEMENT WITH LOPFI, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Bryant Fire Pension and Relief Fund has elected to have its Pension Fund administered by LOPFI as stated by Resolution dated June 16, 2015, and that

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has requested by Resolution that the City of BRYANT, Arkansas to act as its agent henceforth; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryant adopted Ordinance No. 2015-20 authorizing the transfer of the Bryant Fire Pension and Relief Fund to LOPFI; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Pension fund requested an annual 3% cost of living adjustment to be included in the ordinance transferring the fund to LOPFI, that was not included in Ordinance No. 2015-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> If accepted by LOPFI, the administration of the BRYANT Fire Pension and Relief Fund shall be transferred to LOPFI under authority of ACT 364 of 1981, as amended. Such transfer shall mean the administration of the Pension Fund only and not a change in the Pension Fund's benefit program. The City of Bryant approves an annual benefit increase of 3% cost of living adjustment.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to enter into an irrevocable agreement, using a twenty – five (25) year amortization schedule, with LOPFI to administer the BRYANT Fire Pension and Relief Fund as stated in Section 1 hereof.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. It is the intent of the City Council and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified into Code of Ordinances of Bryant, Arkansas and the section thereof may be re-numbered and re-lettered as necessary to accomplish such intention.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. EMERGENCY CLAUSE - Due to the need to consolidate administration of the Bryant Fire Pension and Relief Fund with LOPFI, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force from and after the date of its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-___

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION IN THE CITY OF BRYANT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Saline County voted to authorize the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquour during the general election in November 2014; and

WHEREAS, Saline County authorized the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquor after November 1, 2012, and has more than one hundred (100) active Alcoholic Beverage Control Division permits within the county; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Ann. § 3-9-201 et. seq, authorizes the City of Bryant to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption; and

WHEREAS, Surrounding cities have authorized similar measures for their respective business; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bryant finds that to remain competitive with surrounding Cities and to maintain parity with those Cities' business, adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the continued economic competiveness of the City of Bryant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYANT;

SECTION 1: Grant of Authority

The Sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption as provided for in Ark. Code Ann. § 3-9-201 et. seq. is hereby authorized in the City of Bryant at those locations licenses for such sales by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of the State of Arkansas and as permitted by the City of Bryant under its alcohol sales licensing Ordinance

SECTION 2. Severability

Should any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared or adjudged invalid or unlawful by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the ordinance.

SECTION 3. General Repealer

All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING; A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH UNLIMITED PLAY, INC., A MISSOURI NON-PROFIT CORPORATION; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, The City of Bryant seeks to enter into a cooperative agreement with Unlimited Play Inc., for the purposes of developing a fund raising program and corporate partnerships for the reconstruction of playground facilities at Mills Park; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bryant has negotiated with Unlimited Play, a Missouri Non-Profit corporation whose business is the development, partnership, and fundraising activities for the development of inclusive playground equipment such as the City of Bryant seeks to construct at Mills Park; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRYANT, ARKANSAS;

Rezoning Notification Requirements: The applicant has notified all property owners (within 300' of the site) of the scheduled public hearing. A public hearing announcement was also placed in the Saline County Courier (by city staff) per requirements. As of the date of this report, staff has received one call in support of the request.

Comprehensive Growth Plan: The Comprehensive Plan designates this area as **G4 Intended Growth**. This designation is characterized by a mixture of residential densities, mixed use development and commercial uses near intersections. The proposed rezoning is consistent with a low density residential nature for this area and is similar to the existing, adjacent Cambridge Place Addition.

Preliminary Plat: The proposed preliminary plat (Johnswood Village) indicates a total of 41 residential lots. All lots exceed the minimum 10,000 square foot lot size for the requested R-2 Residential Zoning. Landers Development, also developed the adjacent Cambridge Place Addition. They're stated intent is to build a similar development.

DRC Recommendation: The Development Review Committee (DRC) has reviewed both the rezoning and preliminary plat requests and recommends approval.

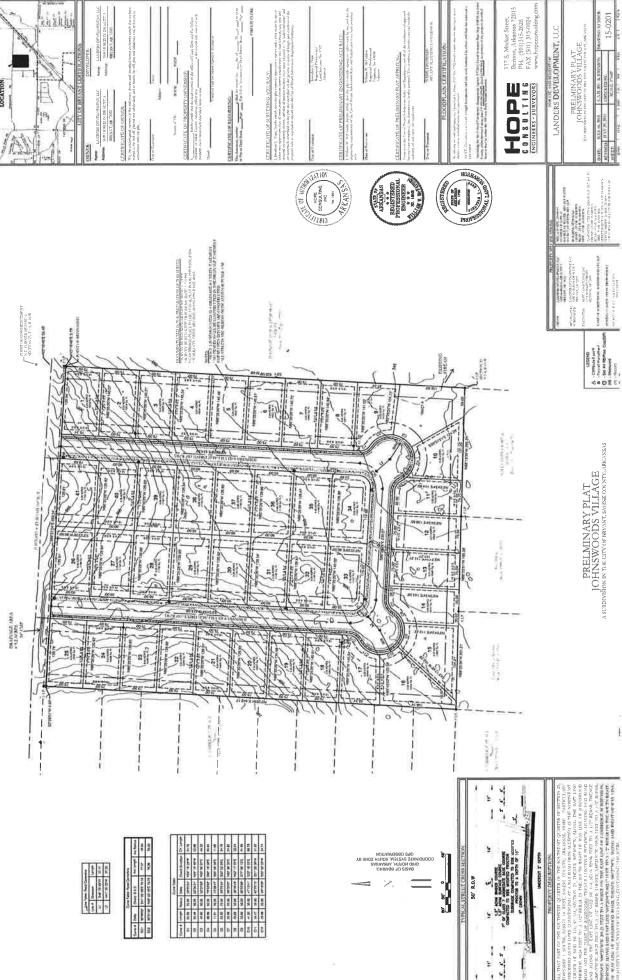

RE: Review of Water and Wastewater Rates for 2016

Dear Mayor Dabbs and Council Members

The first half of 2015 brought the City of Bryant an exceptional amount of rainfall. Wet seasons tend to reduce the consumption of water while increasing the amount of wastewater that has to be treated. The 2015 Budgets for Water and Wastewater were developed based on lower consumption data.

The projected 2015 revenues for water are expected to fall below the budgeted amount while the wastewater revenues are projected to exceed the budgeted amount. The departments have been conservative in spending. Overall, water and wastewater expenses are expected to be lower than the budgeted amounts as well as below the available projected revenues.

The 2016 Budget will be prepared basing the anticipated revenues and expenses on much the same usage and operating activities as in the 2015 budget. Exceptions are the increase in the cost of water purchased and the implementation of the water and wastewater rates for 2016.

Six months into 2015, and based on historical usage information, it appears that water and wastewater revenues will continue to support the 110% debt service requirement in the bond documents and provide for adequate OM&R expenses.
